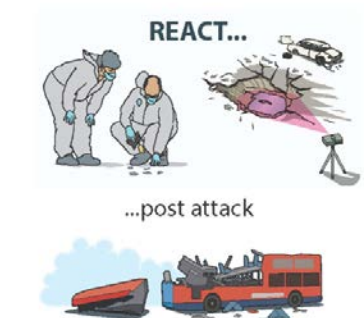
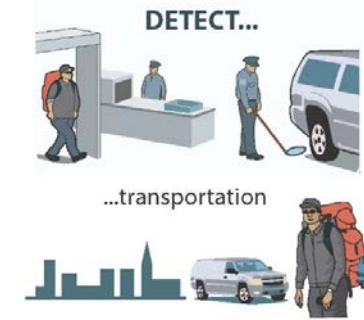
Support practitioners as well as academia, developers and innovators in their search to find potential industrial partners who have the capability to exploit the innovations into products

The EXERTER project will highlight requirements, gaps and activities within research, standardisation and certification, for discussion within the wider network.
